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If tissue is removed during a biopsy or surgical procedure, it may be sent to a laboratory for histopathology. The Medicare item for some skin procedures depends on the pathology result, so the final Medicare billing cannot always be completed on the day of the procedure.

Once the pathology report is received, your GP will review the result and the appropriate Medicare billing can be completed. Your GP may recommend a follow-up appointment to discuss the result and review the wound or procedure site.

Workplace injuries & motor vehicle accidents

Different fees and billing arrangements apply when treatment relates to a workplace injury or motor vehicle accident. Medicare generally cannot be billed where another party may be responsible for the cost of your medical care.

- For workers compensation, please provide your claim number, employer and insurer details where available.
- Where an accepted claim and appropriate billing details are in place, the account may be invoiced directly to the insurer.
- Until liability has been accepted or appropriate billing arrangements are confirmed, you may be personally responsible for payment.

Private fees may also apply for services such as medical forms and reports, commercial or employment medicals, insurance paperwork, medical record requests, and missed or late-cancelled appointments. Please ask reception for the applicable fee before requesting these services.

Telephone & video consultations

Medicare eligibility rules apply to telehealth. In many circumstances you must have attended the practice face-to-face within the previous 12 months. Some longer telephone items are only available to patients registered with the practice through MyMedicare. Please ask reception if you are unsure whether a Medicare rebate will apply.

Bulk billing & reduced fees

Bulk billing or reduced fees may be available to some patients, including eligible concession card holders and children, at the discretion of the individual GP. Please discuss any billing concerns with reception or your GP.

Procedures & treatment room services

Mead Medical provides a range of procedures and treatment room services. Before a procedure is booked, you will usually need to discuss whether it is clinically appropriate with your GP. Not all GPs perform every procedure, so you may be referred to another GP within the practice.

Procedure fees are separate from standard consultation fees and vary according to the procedure performed. All procedure fees listed below include the standard \$58 treatment room fee. Where appropriate, you will be provided with an Informed Financial Consent before booking so that the expected costs and Medicare rebate can be explained.
